

## **Photography Policy and Privacy**

We view the taking of photographic record of member's participation and success as an important activity and also a benefit of your membership and a way to promote membership growth for us. The outsourcing of part of the photography service enables us to provide a higher quality service to you and important fundraising revenue for us.

Photographs taken by us or our agent of yourself or your child as a record of participation in a group or team or in attendance at one of our events, functions or games may be utilized for our organization purposes and activities, which include (but not by way of limitation) illustration, promotion, advertising and recording or our activities and you or your child's participation in our activities. Such photographs may be published by us or the agent in any medium (for example website and social media) and may be labeled with the name of the person/s in the photograph and the event at which the photograph was taken.

We may also use or share with our photography agent your personal contact information to enable them to arrange the time and place for photographs and the viewing and purchase of those photographs by you which is a necessary part of the photography service and your membership.
